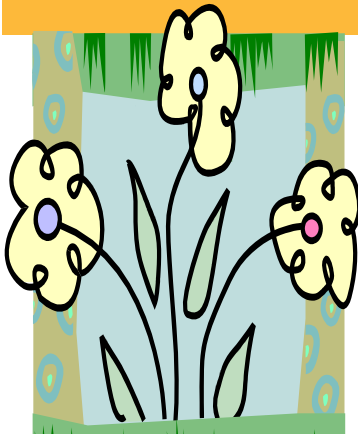
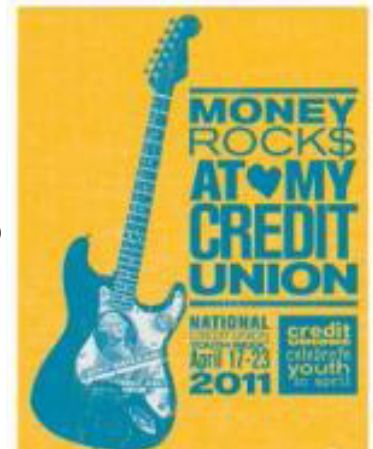

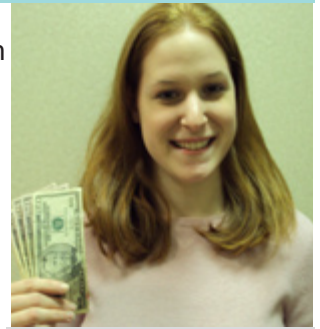
Update your Information
