Mobile Web

Access Mobile Banking from your mobile web browser on your web-enabled phone or smart phone. With the Mobile Web feature you will be able to transfer funds, locate ATMs and many of the same services you can find on our web site, but sized to fit in the palm of your hand, for your phone.

Also, members who have an iPhone, Droid, iPad, iPod or Blackberry will be offered an application (App) to access all of our home banking features.

Bill Pay

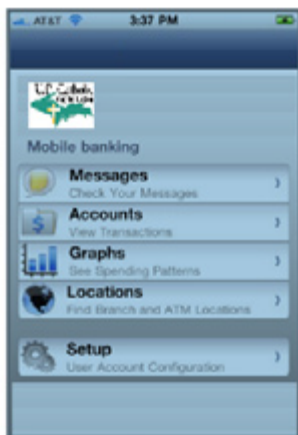
Our Bill Pay Service is going to receive an upgrade and is also going to be offered for FREE to UPCCU checking account members.

You can pay your bills quickly, easily and safely. You can set up payments for anything from a credit card to an individual person. Make a one time payment or schedule a reoccurring payment, the choice is yours. You will also be able to pay bills through our new mobile application.

Online Banking

We will be upgrading our Online Banking Services too. Online Banking already gives you access to your accounts from the convenience of your computer. It allows you to review your accounts, print copies of cleared checks and transfer funds between accounts. Coming soon you will be able to: Set up customized alerts and have an online storage vault or safe deposit box for you to keep copies of important documents safe. There will be a financial management tool that will help track your spending habits, develop budgets and create charts and graphs to help you manage your money. One of the changes that you will notice first is you will be asked to create a unique user id and password to access your accounts. This is a major security enhancement for our online banking. No longer will you use your account number, but a personalized user id and password created by you.

Planning to buy a savings bond? Paper savings bonds will no longer be sold at financial institutions after December 28, 2011. But they're not going away- electronic savings bonds can be purchased online through TreasuryDirect. Open a free TreasuryDirect account today at www.treasurydirect.gov. Already have paper savings bonds? Existing paper bonds are still valid and will earn interest for 30 years from the issue date or until redeemed. You can continue to cash savings bonds at UPCCU. Your U.P. Catholic Union Debit Card will soon have even more security features. These enhancements allow for more fraud detection and preventative measures to minimize unauthorized card activity. You may receive a phone call from the Transaction Review Department to verify your card activity. Caller ID should show 800-327-8622. The callback number should be 888-233-7336.
